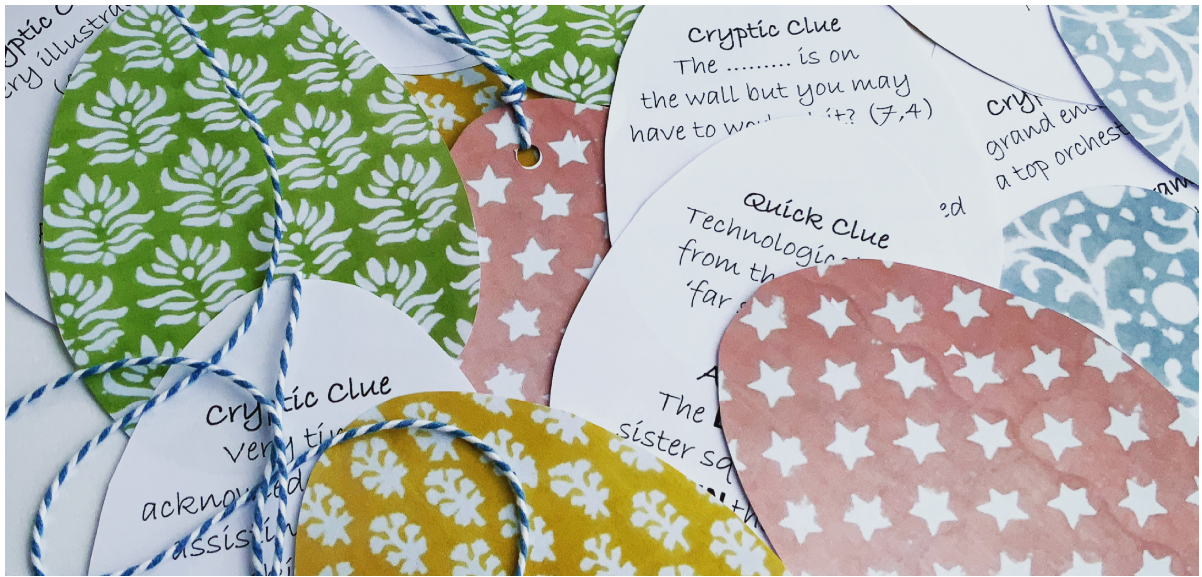


Grown-Up Easter Egg Trail

However, the simple clues I used when they were little are not going to challenge their brain cells, even after a few beers the night before. There seemed to be nothing on the internet, so I've cobbled together a few clues to use around the house and garden.



Simply print off the sheet of eggs, cut them out, place a clue and patterned egg right sides together, punch a hole in the top and tie them together with some ribbon or baker's twine. Select those clues most relevant to your own home and hide them in the correct locations. Keep one clue back for the Easter bunny to present at breakfast to kick the trail off and place the chocolate prize in the last location.

I've listed the answers for each egg below – hopefully, it will be obvious which clue they relate to!

Television, Cat Food, Sofa, Porch, Bookcase, Writing Desk
